The toughest type of work to find at the moment is office or professional work. If you are looking for this type of work, be very persistent with following up your job applications and sign up to a few agencies in your area.

Wednesday Newspapers - the major newspapers around the country have a careers section on Wednesdays

Websites - Seek and Trademe are good

Recruitment Agencies - Alpha, Adecco, Madison and OCG are large reputable recruitment firms
